Thank you for your interest in applying for one of our coaching research grants. Our mission is to inspire and fund coaching research.

Before applying for a grant, please submit a 1 -2 page application letter that in essence, is a brief pre-proposal. This will enable us to give you preliminary feedback on whether your proposed research is consistent with our funding brief and whether we recommend that you submit a full grant application.

Please send us a document with the following information:

- Your name;
- Your institutional affiliation;
- Your contact details;
- The names and affiliations of your key collaborators;
- A descriptive title of your proposed project; and
- An estimate of the funding support you will request.

Then please write a clear, concise overview of your proposed project that includes a description of:

1. The general topic and the specific questions it will address. If appropriate please state the hypotheses to be tested.
2. Its significance for the field of coaching
3. What measures and research methods you plan to use.
4. What findings you anticipate.
5. Its estimated duration.

This overview should be single-spaced and should not exceed a half-page.

Please be aware that an invitation from the Institute of Coaching to submit a full application does not guarantee funding.
